Burbank Hall and Campground – Rules – 2023 Camping Season

- 1. 1 sleeping unit allowed per site.
 - People are not allowed to sleep in sheds. Sheds are not safe and some do not provide an escape exit if a fire starts or another emergency takes place.
- 2. 1 storage shed allowed per site, no larger than 8'x8'.
- 3. 1 portable deck allowed per site, no larger than 8'x10'.
 - All existing sheds and decks that have been approved are grandfathered in.
- Any additional units (trailers or tents) in your site must pay the regular nightly rate.
 Nightly rates do not apply to children (under 18) staying in tents.
- 5. *NEW* If you want a fence to create privacy, you may request to management via email. All fences must be treated brown fence boards and be 6ft tall.
- 6. All tarps must be green and no larger than 150 square feet.
 - All tarps must be taken down at the end of each season.
- 7. Sites must be kept in a neat and tidy condition.
- 8. Roadways must be kept clear of all vehicles, boats and debris.
- 9. Non-overnight visitors must quietly leave the campground by 11:00pm.
- 10. Electrical units are not permitted outside of your camping unit/sheds.
- 11. Air conditioning units must only be on if you are in your site.
 - If you are out on the water, please turn off your A/C units.
- 12. Site lighting must be kept to a reasonable amount.
 - Please be conscious of your neighbours and the amount of light being put off.
 - Noise must only be heard from within your campsite, please be conscious of your neighbours at all times.
- 13. Site changes and improvements (example: gravel or sheds) must be requested and approved in writing by campground management.
- 14. No cutting, digging of trees or bushes allowed without expressed permission from management.
- 15. Only kitchen waste is allowed in the centrally located garbage bin.
 - You are responsible for the removal for all large objects such as lawn chairs, mowers, tarps, big boxes, rugs, etc.
- 16. If you are planning on taking your camping unit out of the campground, please inform the campground caretaker.
- 17. If someone else is using your camping unit while you are away, they must pay a nightly camping rate.
 - Your adult children are **not** subject to overnight camping fees if they use your trailer while you're away. We trust all of our campers to be reasonable with this allowance.
 - You are still responsible for your site and the conduct of those staying in your site/trailer.
- 18. Please do not disturb, feed or bother the horses on neighbouring properties.
- 19. Do not park in other sites parking area without permission.

- 20. The campground managers and all employees are not responsible for vandalism, theft, or loss of any items left in your campsite.
- 21. The campground managers are not responsible for any injuries to you, your children or guests.
 - Camp at your own risk.
- 22. There is no recreational ATV's, golf-carts or motorbikes allowed in the campground.
- 23. 2 pets are allowed per site (dogs, cats).
- 24. Pets must be quiet and are not allowed to make unreasonable amounts of noise.
- 25. Pets must always be on a leash.
 - Please clean up after your pets.
- 26. Quiet time is11:00pm, all children must be in their sites at this time and music must be off. No loud music allowed at anytime. No fireworks allowed at anytime.
- 27. No generators allowed in the group camping area. The shelters have power.
- 28. The speed limit through-out the campground is 10km/hour.
- 29. NO dumping of grey or black waste is allowed in your campsite, outhouses or anywhere throughout the campground. Such activity will result in immediate eviction.
- 30. Septic dumps cost \$30 dollars (cash only). * *This is subject to change for the 2023 season pending negotiations with Dumpco and/or another provider.*
 - The \$30 dollars must be put in an envelope and placed into the drop box by Wednesday (before 3:00pm).
 - The septic truck comes Friday's <u>if</u> there are enough dumps. Additional septic pulls (tidy tanks) are \$5 dollars each.
 - If there is no envelope, there will be no dump.
 - You are responsible for proper access to your trailer when the septic truck arrives. Please ensure there is adequate water inside the tank.
- 31. At the end of each camping season your site must be clean and all items removed or placed inside your secured shed.
 - BBQ's, firewood, picnic tables, decks, and things of that nature can be left as long as the overall site looks clean and tidy.
 - If you are storing your trailer in the campground and in your site, everything must be unplugged and winterized. You will not have access to your trailer in the off season.
- 32. All seasonal campers must follow the latest Covid-19 regulations and guidelines provided by the Government or Alberta Health Services (AHS).
 - It is each camper's personal responsibility to stay in the "know" on the latest rules relating to the Covid-19 virus.
- 33. Failure to follow the campground rules may result in eviction and loss of your lot without refunds.
- 34. Campground management reserves the right to terminate this agreement at anytime, for any reason.
 - \circ $\;$ Site refunds are at the discretion of management.
